1. Entry fees are non-refundable.

3. Hard Hats with fastened chinstraps that comply with BSI EN 4472/6473, and proper footwear must be worn at all times.
4. The Organisers recommend that an approved body protector is worn.
5. The Organisers reserve the right to retire any horse or pony that appears to be in any way distressed or unfit.
6. Riders under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
7. No horses or ponies under 4 years old.
8. Flu-vac is recommended within six months of the ride (optional)
9. Competitors must keep on the marked route of the ride and show consideration to other riders, particularly when overtaking.
10. Each entrant is responsible for collecting amounts promised to them and for paying them to the organisers in a timely manner.
11. Any St. John s Ambulance, Blacksmith or Veterinary fee will be the responsibility of the rider or owner
